

For Year 10 students in teaching group **10A** to return to school from **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June** for **2 days a week** on **Tuesdays and Wednesdays** between **10am-12.30pm**.

For Year 10 students in teaching group **10B** to return to school from **Thursday 18th June** for **2 days a week** on **Thursdays and Fridays** between **10am-12.30pm**.

For all Year 10 students to return to their work experience placements at Envirohort or Southside Construction every Monday from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June.

- Students to arrive at the prescribed staggered times for their group.
- Students may only enter and exit the building through the main reception doors.
- **All students** must use the supplied hand sanitiser on arrival before passing through the reception area.
- **All students will have their temperature checked with a non-contact infra-red device on arrival** and if a high temperature is shown then they will be sent home and their family contacted
- Students will retain their outer clothing and bags and the locker area will not be available for use.

**Social distancing to be maintained at all times and at least 2 metres.**

**Hand washing before starting work and after visiting the toilets and prior to eating and drinking.**

**Hands to be washed for at least 20 seconds in hot soapy water.**

**Hand Sanitiser is available and should be used as and when required.**

**Avoid touching face as much as possible.**

## Guidance for Year 10 Students ONLY

- All students must use the supplied hand sanitiser on arrival in reception.
- Students will exit reception via staff area and make their way to the main hall via the staff staircase.
  - 10.00am-10.45am Session 1 (English)
  - 10.45am-11.30am Session 2 (Maths)
  - 11.30am-12.15pm Session 3 (Science)
  - 12.15pm-12.30pm lunch
- Students will be seated according to a prepared seating plan and this will remain in place for all sessions. The hall on Floor 4 will be the assigned 'learning hub'
- Teaching staff assigned to the Year 10 cohort will remain with the students at all times whilst they in the building.
- Students will receive an assigned pencil case that must not be shared and will be used for each session.
- Year 10 students one at a time, will only use the staff toilet on Floor 4 and students waiting should remain at their assigned work space.
- Refreshments and lunch will be provided but will be brought to the main hall space for student to access.
- Classroom space on floor 3 may be used with prior notification to Vice Principal and site staff to allow for adequate cleaning and containment.
- Hand sanitising and hand washing should be an embedded practice throughout the sessions.
