

AZTEC ADVENTURE Water Park Activity Days July 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to write to you to share details of our forthcoming activity days to Aztec Adventure Aqua Park at Upton Warren near Bromsgrove. As a continued aspect of our 'Safe, Ready, Respectful' curriculum we are inviting all students to take on the challenges of the floating Aqua Park.



The trips will operate as follows;

- **Wednesday 07th July – 10B students only.**
 - The minibus will leave school promptly at **9.00am** and will return at approximately 2.00pm. Students will be free to leave from school upon return at 2.00pm in recognition of the full day of offsite activities that they will have been actively participating within.
- **Thursday 08th July – 10A students only.**
 - The minibus will leave school promptly at **9.30am** and will return approximately 2.00pm. Students will be free to leave from school upon return at 2.00pm in recognition of the full day of offsite activities that they will have been actively participating within.
- **Tuesday 13th July – Year 9 students only.**
 - The minibus will leave school promptly at **9.30am** and will return approximately 2.00pm. Students will be free to leave from school upon return at 2.00pm in recognition of the full day of offsite activities that they will have been actively participating within.
- **Friday 16th July – Year 7 and 8 students only.**
 - The minibus will leave school promptly at **9.00am** and will return approximately 2.00pm. Students will be free to leave from school upon return at 2.00pm in recognition of the full day of offsite activities that they will have been actively participating within.

All entry costs, wetsuit hire and transport will be covered by the Edge Academy, so there is no charge to families.

All participants will be given a hired wetsuit and a buoyancy aid to wear so you must bring a swimming costume/trunks to wear underneath the wetsuit whilst in the water. Students must be able to swim with a buoyancy aid, without the help of others. You are likely to go under water and should be confident in the water. You also have to complete a short swim to the Aqua Park to gain access.

Its is advised that you participate barefoot but please ensure you bring flip flops/sliders/trainers to wear. This is as there is a gravel track from the changing rooms to the Aqua Park.

All jewellery and watches must be removed before you enter the park. This includes ALL removable earrings. We will still take part in the rain. Our theory is...you are going to get wet anyway! It is good fun in the rain.

A towel and a change of clothes to put on after is strongly recommended.

Lunch, refreshments and drinks will be provided as part of the trip, however there may be opportunity for students to access other refreshments should they wish to bring a small amount of money themselves. This is optional and not necessarily required.

Students will be admitted to the Aqua Park subject to their published entry conditions. If students do not comply with the entry conditions, they will not be permitted access to the Aqua Park or may be removed from the Aqua Park without any right to a refund
