

## Year 9 Worcester Cultural Capital Visit May 2022

Dear Parents/Carers,

Student enrichment experiences are a vital part of our **Safe, Ready, Respectful** curriculum at the Edge Academy. School visits to different environments and places outside of the local area form a key aspect of that provision.

We are planning to give further such opportunities to students in our Year 9 group on **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May 2022**.

Students will travel by minibus to the historic rural city of Worcester to take part in a river walk, visit the racecourse and see city landmarks. They will have a packed lunch by the river. There will then be 30 minutes independent shopping time in the high street.

Finally, a visit to Top Barn Farm shop to see/feed animals. All students will need to arrive in school by 9.15am and will return to school by 2.00 for dismissal.

All participants will need to wear comfortable clothing and trainer type shoes. The minibus will leave school promptly at 9.30pm. Students will be free to leave from school upon return at 2.00pm.

Lunch, refreshments and drinks will be provided as part of the trip, however there may be opportunity for students to access other refreshments should they wish to bring a small amount of money themselves.
