Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you and your child are well at the start of the Autumn Term. It has been a pleasure to welcome our students back to school today and we look forward to working with them at the beginning of another academic year.

Due to our sustained success and having now been an oversubscribed school for a long period of time, we have expanded our staffing for 2023/24 in order to meet need for our increased PAN of 70 students. This is in addition to our settled existing staff body from which no staff have departed since 2021. We would like to give a warm welcome to Rebecca Inman (Teacher of English), Karen O'Donovan (Teacher of Science), Jane Olly (Teacher of Humanities), Jack O'Hagan (Teacher of PE and Well-Being), Samantha Pearson (Careers Co-Ordinator), Toni Baker (Cook), Rachael McGurin (Teaching Assistant) and Sharon McKenna (Pastoral Officer). Marishia Sutherland (Teaching Assistant) and Joey Harvey (Pastoral Officer) also continue to work with us this term.

We would like to make you are aware too of a number of existing staff who start new roles with us this term. Helen McClane and Calum Hill are now Assistant Principals, Katie Stone is now our Literacy Co-Ordinator and Lana Walker is now a Teacher of Maths.

The combination of all of these new appointments mean that we have significantly broadened our academic curriculum at the start of 2023/24. In addition to all of the academic subjects we offered previously, we now offer the following four new courses at Key Stage 4: Religious Education, Health and Social Care, Sport, Exercise and Fitness and Public Services.
