

## **Year 11 Enrichment Sessions**

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, students' GCSE examinations are approaching: the first starting on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2024. There are 15 exams in total between 10<sup>th</sup> May and 19<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

Prior to this, students are also completing non-exam assessments in GCSE Food Preparation and Nutrition, Media Studies, Art, Health and Social Care, Public Services and Sport and Fitness.

To support students with this as much as we possibly can, and in response to student voice, we are implementing a change to Friday's enrichment activities whereby Year 11 students have an opportunity to focus on their GCSE examinations rather than completing normal enrichment sessions.

Students have been given every GCSE revision for free to utilise at home. These include:

- CGP AQA revision guide and workbook for Mathematics Grades 9 1
- CGP AQA revision guide and workbook for Physics Grades 9 1
- CGP AQA revision guide and workbook for Religious Studies (Buddhism and Christianity) Grades 9 1
- CGP AQA revision guide and workbook for Food Preparation and Nutrition Grades 9 1

If successfully applying for the option to study from home, students will leave school at 12.00pm every Friday for the final eight enrichment sessions of 2024.

The expectation will be to complete revision and study independently at home. If you would like us to consider a request for your child to do this, please complete the proforma below and we will authorise this on a case-by-case basis.

It is imperative that we do everything we can to support our students in achieving the very best outcomes they can and help them gain the best life chances.

If you would like your child to remain in school on a Friday to complete enrichment sessions, they will leave school at 2.00pm as normal. Please note that the Saturday revision sessions start on Saturday 20th April 2024: 10am – 12pm
