The Year 10 GCSE Mock Examinations will take place between Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> February 2024 and Friday 1st March 2024. We are taking this opportunity to support your child in understanding how their GCSE examinations will take place in May/ June 2024.

Students with additional learning needs and those who are given extra time will be supported in another learning environment within school to ensure their needs are met. We will speak to all students explicitly about this to allay any worries they may have.
