Student enrichment experiences are a vital part of our "Safe, Ready, Respectful" curriculum at The Edge Academy and school visits to different environments and places outside of the local area form a key aspect of that provision.

We are planning to give further such opportunities to students during the week beginning Monday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2024. The visits are part of our curriculum offer and as such there will be no alternative on-site provision if your child is not on the trip.

All participants will need to wear comfortable, warm clothing (possibly waterproofs – weather dependent); open toe shoes, sandals or sliders are not recommended.

We will use the school minibus. **All trips will leave by 9.45am and return at around 2.15pm.** Year 10 students will be free to leave from school upon return at 2.15pm in recognition of the full day of offsite activities that they will have been actively participating within.

Lunch and drinks will be provided, however there may be an opportunity for students to access other refreshments should they wish to bring a small amount of money themselves. This is optional and not necessarily required.

- Going on funfair rides at Treasure Island in Stourport-on-Severn;
- Having a fish and chip shop lunch in Stourport.
